Bo Bear

A Brief Description

This learning module introduces the delightful character of Bo Bear. Four activities encourage children to help Bo dress herself by identifying and choosing appropriate clothes. Music and narration all help to develop early reading and logic skills.

Tips on using “Dress Bo Bear”

Bo Bear’s clothes can be moved by click, drag and drop or by click and click again to release the item.

1. Bo likes to wear - Dress Bo in any order.
2. Bo dresses to go out - Dress Bo in the appropriate clothing for her day out.
3. Bo gets dressed - Dress Bo in the correct sequence.
4. Bo’s missing sock - Move the matching sock to Bo’s foot.
