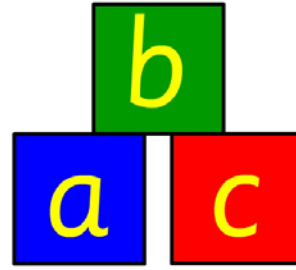

Letter Matching

A Brief Description

Graded activities introduce the initial letters of everyday objects, providing the opportunity to discuss letter sounds and match them to the appropriate object. Develops mouse skills and co-ordination with success being rewarded with lively animations.

Tips on using “Letter Matching”

Game 1 (Match the Symbol) Choosing a starting point within the alphabet, the children are then given a symbol with its starting letter. The children need to click on the matching symbol. Success is rewarded with animations.

Game 2 (Match Symbols to Initial Letters) The children are given a letter and have to click on the appropriate picture below. Success is rewarded with animations.
