### A Brief Description

The Newspaper Office is a 'who dunnit' adventure with three word comprehension activities. Names must be sorted into alphabetical order, the correct homophone must be chosen from a list of possibilities (e.g. rain/reign/rein) and an antonym crossword needs to be completed. Finally, with the clues provided, the identity of the guilty person must be deduced.

### Tips on using "Newspaper Office"

Clicking on the pink window on the introductory scene, opens a view of the editor's office.

Additional information is available by clicking on the ringing phones, with each activity being accessed by clicking on the competition papers on the editor's desk.

On completion of each exercise, a clue is provided and the staff files accessed by clicking on the editor's computer screen.

Within the staff files, each person can be toggled between suspect and not a suspect, until the guilty member of staff is identified.
