A complex carbohydrate found in foods made from corn, wheat, potato or rice.		starch
A group of complex organic molecules that contain carbon, hydrogen, oxygen, nitrogen. Usually found in meat, fish and eggs.		protein
The organs in your chest that allow you to breathe.		lungs
The organ that pumps blood around your body.		heart
The red liquid pumped around your body by your heart.		blood
The organ in your skull that thinks and controls all your actions.		brain
All the bones in your body.		skeleton
The coloured part of a plant where reproduction occurs.		flower
The transfer of pollen from one plant to another.		pollination
The fertile parts of a plant that can grow into new plants.		seeds
The usually sweet and fleshy edible part of a plant containing seeds.		fruit
The combining of pollen with an ovule in plants or sperm and an egg in animals.		fertilisation
The sexual or asexual process by which living things (animals and plants) create new individuals, or offspring.		reproduction
